EDITORIAL

As young people in Canada who frequent the theatre regularly, or the cinema, as it is called in the USSR we are bound to have quite an extensive knowledge of the types of films shown by the American movie industry. It is interesting to note that movies are made in the Soviet Union as well.

How seriously the Soviet people and their government regard the motion picture industry is attested to by the establishment of a Ministry of Cinematography of the USSR and by the practice of awarding Stalin prizes for outstanding work to producers, directors, scenarists, cameramen, and actors. Film actors and technicians hold several other awards and titles, such as People's Artist and Honored Artist.

Cinematography is seriously studied as an art form in the Soviet Union. Since its foundation 26 years ago the State Institute of Cinematography has graduated more than a thousand producers, directors, screen writers, cameramen, and actors. Among its alumni are such outstanding names of the Soviet film world as Sergei Vasiliev, one of the producers of "Chapayev"; Vsevolod Pudovkin, producer of "Mother"; and many well-known film stars.

In the Institute are movie lots and studios, an extensive library of Russian and foreign films, and a special scenario library. Students produce their own films on these lots, duplicating in every aspect the experience of professional film production. The gifted young actress Galina Vodyanitskaya, who became an international star for her portrayal of the young partisan heroine in the film "Zoya", is one of the many who have made names for themselves while still students.

Compare that with the movie production of Hollywood where everything is handled by a few top producers. We also have another comparison and that is the type of pictures produced. The Soviet film industry announced a five-year plan for new films which will stress the following themes:

1. The advantages of the Soviet regime over capitalism.
2. The role of the Communist Party.
3. Solidarity and friendship of the many nationalities composing the Soviet Union.
4. The people's vigilance, patriotism and duties to the state.
5. Commemoration of outstanding war heroes and heroines.
6. The Soviet way of life.
7. The family.
8. Mother heroines (with ten children).
9. Children and youth.
10. Documentation of the five-year plan.
11. Problems facing the Soviet Union.
12. Popularization of achievements in science, engineering and technical progress.

The film studios of the United States also seem to have a plan. The new Hollywood films in preparation and production will stress

the following themes:

1. Crime does not pay.
2. Woman's place is in the kitchen.
3. Problems of the idle rich.
4. People are funny.
5. Love conquers all.
6. Horse thieves still roam the wild west.
7. Be kind to animals.
8. Dracula rules the laboratory.
9. The white man's burden.
10. East is East.
11. Say it with atom-bombs.
12. Life can be beautiful. Enough said!

Labor Youth Calls National Parliament

"The hopes of Canadian youth for a new deal and a secure future in peace time have been rudely shattered in the first year of peace," stated Bill Stewart of Toronto, to the National Organization Committee for a Labor Youth Parliament.

"Young Canadians are clamouring for a chance to take action to meet and solve the many problems that confront them and this Parliament offers them a step in the right direction", he said.

Youth from all parts of Canada are invited to send delegates — Trade Unions, Churches, Cultural and fraternal organizations, students, farmers, and veterans.

The National Federation of Labor Youth led a delegation of one hundred young people to Parliament Hill last April and presented the Cabinet with a twenty-page brief on the demands of youth for a post-war program.

Mr. Stewart, who is the executive secretary of the federation, stated here that the program put before the youth Parliament in the form of draft bills is substantially the same as that endorsed by many youth organizations at that time. The major issues will be Peace, wages, jobs, recreation, Health, and education.

"We youth are fed up with the role of a small junior partner in the affairs of our country. In the war we made the greatest single contribution of any section of the population," continued Stewart, who is a wounded veteran of the Italian campaign. "Let us play an equally significant part in peace. Our future lives will be governed by the policies of our Government today, why, therefore, should we have so little to say in shaping these policies now?"

The Parliament is being held in Toronto, Nov. 29-30, and Dec. 1. Fraternal delegates will attend from Latin America and U.S.A.

"The Four Freedoms Now" is the slogan of the Parliament — a reminder of the widely disseminated wartime promises.

For Peace and Better Life

The W. F. D. Y. Council which met at the end of July in Paris, has issued a call to all Democratic Youth:

To celebrate World Youth Day, Nov. 10, as a day of international friendship and co-operation. Peace is not yet secure! Thousands of young people died for Peace and a Better Life for our generation in the war against fascism. Their challenge to us on World Youth Day 1946 is to strengthen and unite our efforts for Peace and Better Life through building a strong and powerful world Federation of Democratic Youth!

We in Canada must plan and prepare now to celebrate World Youth Day. Here are some suggestions for action on Nov. 10:

1. Plan large public meetings in co-operation with other youth groups.
2. Send messages or greetings to youth in other countries.
3. Make it a day of sacrifice and special effort in your club by: a) Making a special collection of levies per head in aid of the W.F.D.Y.; b) "Adopting" the youth of some other country, club, or village, exchanging messages or information with them,

collecting materials to help them if they are in devastated or colonial countries.

4. Arrange for special broadcasts and press releases.

Through the bulletins issued by the W.F.D.Y. we learn of the heroic work being done by the youth of Yugoslavia. These same young Yugoslavians who contributed so magnificently to the common victory, now carry on, helping not only by rebuilding their war-torn country but also by undertaking the tremendous task of building a completely new railway which will open up a potentially rich industrial district and the largest coal mine in Yugoslavia.

Engineers say that such a railway would take at least two years to complete but the Yugoslav youth pledged themselves to complete the project in only five and a half months!

The bulletins of the W.F.D.Y. have brought to our attention the deplorable situation in Greece where the police, acting like bandits, using Hitlerite methods, set fire to the EPON club offices; tortured and killed the young members; arrested and executed peasant democrats; arrested and de-

ported whole administrative councils.

The W.F.D.Y. council proposes that we in Canada take every possible step to help the Greek youth and to support all efforts for the establishment of real democracy in Greece. All organizations are urged to send resolutions to the Prime Minister, to the Canadian Delegate to the U.N. Council and to the members of Parliament from their own districts.

Valstybinis Vytauto Vardo Universitet. Pradėjo Darbą

Kauno universitetas pradėjo savo darbą rugsėjo 12 dieną.

Reikia pažymėti, kad šie mokslo metai buvo pradėti po pirmojo Lietuvoje Stalinio penkmečio ženklų. Penkmečio Plano įstatymas įpareigoja mus likviduoti vokiškosios okupacijos padarinių likučius: pilnumoje atstatyti ir atkurti pramonę, žemės ūkį, atgaivinti kultūros įstaigas ir toliau vystyti mūsų liaudies ūkį.

Pagrindiniai universiteto uždaviniai yra tokie: 1. paruošti aukštai kvalifikuotus kadrus, 2. tinkamai išugdyti šiuos kadrus, kad jie taptų naudingais socialistinės visuomenės nariais, 3. visą universiteto mokslinį-pedagoginį personalą įtraukti į planingą mokslo tyrimo darbą.

Siais metais mandatų komisija labai kruopščiai atrinko stojančius į universitetą abiturientus. Į pirmą kursą išviso buvo paduoti 1,265 pareiškimai. Po kruopščios atrankos į universitetą buvo priimta 914 studentų. Priimtųjų tarpe yra 34 Tėvynės karo invalidai.

Į medicinos fakultetą buvo priimta 357 žmonės, į technologijos — 236, į istorijos-filosofijos — 144, į architektūros — 64, statybos — 113. Šiais mokslo metais studentų skaičius sieks 3,000 žmonių. 250 žmonių iš darbininkų ir valstiečių tarpo bus priimti į kursus, kurie paruos juos pastojimui į universitetą.
